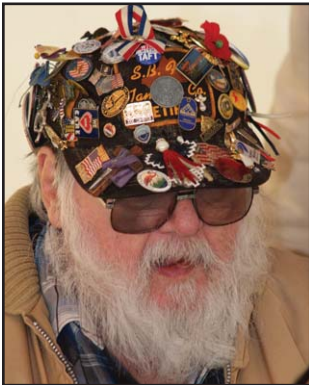

Minnesota Vet's Home Opener Saturday

The Twin Cities chapter has held a "fishing opener" at the Minnesota Veterans Home for years. It is an event that the residents look forward to all year. Saturday, May 2 a trout pond will be set up at the Home and residents, hopefully, will catch some trout for a "shore lunch" served to all. VFW post 6099 and others provide the funding for this event.

Volunteers will be needed to help the residents while they fish as well as with the cooking the meal, cleaning fish and generally making this a fun event. Be at the Veterans Home by Minnehaha Falls around 7 am (many residents are lined up waiting early in the day). Capable Partners Outing is June 14

Share your love for the pursuit of muskies with a fellow outdoorsmen on Lake Independence at the Baker Park Reserve. Our annual outing with physically challenged members of Capable Partners will take place June 14 from 6:30 am to "shore lunch" time. 15 volunteers with boats will be needed. About one-half of participants will need space for wheelchairs, but any size boat can be matched with one of the Capable Partners.

You don't have to be a Lake Independence whiz to participate. Organizer Paul Hartman will gladly go over lure selection and the "hot spots" with anyone. You don't have to have a boat to join in. A "shore lunch" will end the event and help is needed for that as well. And if you show up, someone with a boat might invite you to continue fishing in the afternoon. Youth Events

The first part of the Muskies Inc. logo tells us that YOUTH should be one of our focuses. To that end our chapter has partnered with Fishing For Life for youth activities. That association has resulted in contacting over 5,000 kids in the first three of four events: the Fish Fair, the NW Sportsman's Show, and the Muskie Expo.

Our message is getting out. At the Fish Fair, Boy Scouts visited our booth to obtain specific information on the differences between Muskies and Northern Pike. With this information they got credit towards the earning of their Fishing Merit Badge. At the NW Sportsman's Show kids participated in a scavenger hunt, which involved obtaining answers five questions by visiting various show booths, including the MI Chapter booth. With answers in hand they received a bag full of fishing gear and information. And at the Muskie Expo there were a number of games the kids could play while being exposed to Muskie-fishing tackle and techniques. The Muskie Expo also sponsored a booth where kids could learn how to build their own bucktails and jigs.

The next event with Fishing For Life will be our June family night.

And finally, we will be participating in a fishing outing on Lake Minnetonka in August (presently planned for Friday/ Saturday, August 21/22, at Maynards' docks). We are trying to involve kids of deployed military families through Operation Military Kids.

From Our President

Spring is here. Finally. Even though the weather guys say we had an old fashioned, normal winter; I thought it was colder and longer than we have had lately. Will it affect our muskie fishing? Who knows? I hope for better than last year.

Our club has been busy this winter and spring. The show season is over and we are all looking forward to the upcoming fishing. Have you got your license yet? Is your boat ready? How about all that gear you have? Have all those new baits had their hooks sharpened? You probably have taken care of those things, but here is one you need to consider.

If you are planning on going on one of our club trips to Canada, you need to have a passport or one of those special entry IDs. Start getting those now. At the Expo, I visited with Peg and Bob Hunger, owners of Whitefish Bay Camp on Lake of the Woods and members of our club and great sponsors of our events.

Besides the passport you will need something new to fish in Ontario this year. It is called an Outdoor Card. It serves the same purpose as a duck stamp. You buy the license to hunt, but then you need to get the stamp to pursue ducks. Ontario residents

have needed to buy this in previous years. Now Ontario is requiring non-residents to also buy this card to go with the fishing license. The cost is \$9 and it's good for 3 years. When and where you get your license is the time and place to get the Outdoor Card. Isn't it amazing how all governments find interesting ways to raise money? But it is not a tax!

Our club has two special events that we participate in, The Vets Home Opener and Capable Partners. Come join us in helping with these activities. The Vets Home Opener is held on May 2nd the weekend before Walleye (Bottom Feeder) opener. We set up a trout pond and let these old warriors go fishing. It may be the best thing you do all year. 7-12 a.m. The Capable Partners event is June 14. Join us for that as well.

Besides these events we have club outings, youth events, fishing league, interclub fishing challenges, and club-run tournaments coming up. There are lots of opportunities to get involved with your club. Plan on joining in.

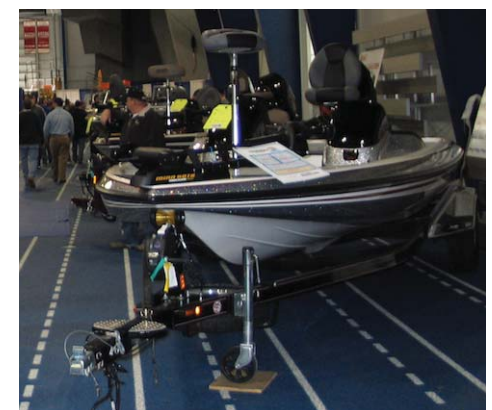
Kids Fishing Contest

Have fun, go fishing with your kid and help them learn about the different species of fish. Children who are members or have a parent or guardian who is a member of the Twin Cities Chapter and are age 12 or younger as of January 1, 2009 are eligible to participate in the chapter Kids Fishing Contest.

The rules are simple. All fish must be caught by using legal means and the fish must be witnessed by a parent or another adult. An award will be given to each and every child who participates. Panfish, catfish, carp, bullhead, bass, walleye, sauger, or pike of any size qualify.

One entry per child should be submitted for the entire 2009 fishing season. Be sure to keep track of your child's catches all on one form. Include anything special about a fish or a trip (1st fish, biggest fish or most fish in one day, Grandpa's secret spot, caught more than Dad, etc.).
