## **First Annual Hugh C. Becker Foundation Donation to Muskies Inc.**

The Hugh C. Becker Foundation awarded the first annual installment check in the amount of \$44,164.93 to the Twin Cities Chapter of Muskies, Inc. at the monthly January meeting. The funds are NOT for the exclusive use of Twin Cities Chapter projects BUT ONLY for grants available to the muskie world. These funds are to be administered by the Foundation Committee whose responsibility is to evaluate and to determine what projects will be the successful recipients of funds.

Grants are available for any worthwhile project that benefits muskie fisheries or conservation, not specifically to projects of our chapter. Specifics of projects that qualify for grants were listed in last month's newsletter and also in the the January issue of *Muskie Magazine*, in the "News and Views" section in the Twin City Chapter's report.

## **Start Planning for Next Season**

### **ANDY MEYER'S LODGE – EAGLE LAKE**

We have set up a trip to Andy Meyer's Lodge on Eagle Lake in Ontario for the week of August 2-9. Eagle Lake is a terrific muskie and walleye fishery and this will be a new moon period. The week includes housekeeping cabin, guide trip, seminars and a Wednesday free fish fry for the entire camp. There is access to five remote lakes and if you want, fly-in trips can be arranged. What many don't know is that the water used is polluted and can't be purified very easily. This has caused some HUGE problems with aquifers in the southwest part of the state being completely dried up. CRP land is also being plowed under at a historic rate due to the increased price of corn due to ethanol. This is all bad for the environment that we like to recreate in, but what's even more disturbing is that Minnesota legislature wants to increase our ethanol production by six times over the next decade or so. This is a topic that we all must get versed in and communicate our concerns to our legislators.*

*We're still looking for a few more people to be on the Executive Board and/or on committees. If you're interested in giving back to the club and the resource feel free to get in touch with me and I can get you more information. We are very blessed that our club does so many things that benefit the resource and its members. In order to keep that up we need people to help shoulder some of the work. 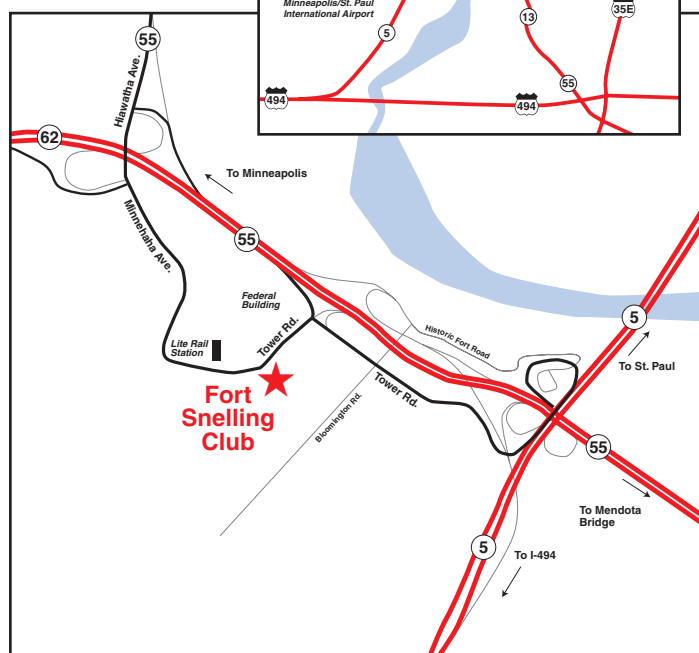

# 2008 Tournament News

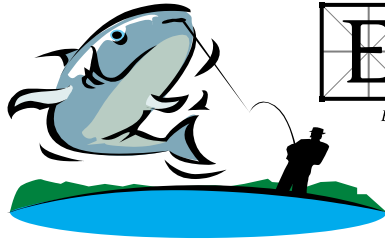
from Ron Sanders, Tournament Committee Chair
